

















Conceptual Plan - showing grading from landscape and public domain to enclosed private internal realm

The design for this home integrates the landscape and house. The design is divided into two wings, the steel and glass left wing extends into the landscape and floats above the pool the solid walled right wing encloses more private and contained spaces to which the family can retreat and hide. These two wings are both divided and joined by the central hearth. This hearth also provides the datumn level for the house, it is at table level \_750mm\_ in relation to the right dining wing and just above floor level of the left wing lounge and terrace.
